Personal Narrative Ring Directions:

Goal: To help students share personal narratives so that their information is sequential and includes the needed details for a peer or adult listener to follow what they are trying to share.

Materials: Print the Personal Narrative cue cards, laminate, cut, punch a hole in the upper left hand corner of each card and put them on a ring.

Ways to use: the ring:

1. Practice using the ring with sequencing cards to help the student share a narrative with picture support.

2. Model for a student how to share a personal story with the ring, have them share their narrative and then practice it with a variety of listeners (teachers and peers) to encourage multiple practices and generalization.
