

Christmas Shopping Activity

- Can use for really any age! Can use for many purposes!
- Was created for a prep lesson for my HS class of students with multiple disabilities that was going on a field trip Christmas shopping. I made it to help with organization and for a language lesson. You could use it for artic, really can adapt and use for any type of lesson or even just for fun☺

Lesson Ideas:

- Make list on board of people they may buy Christmas gifts for (friend, grandparents, parents, aunts, uncles, brothers/sisters, etc)
- Then use 2 pages of large icons that you have printed, cut and laminated to have children decide gifts that may be appropriate for different people. I passed the icons out to the kids and had them describe the item, tell where you can buy it/look for it, then had them stick the icons on white board under the person that you would buy this gift for.
- Next use the worksheet with the students. Depending on the level of independence, you can have them complete it using the small icon sheet or do it together as a class. If students think of other things they can always draw or write it in the boxes provided.
- Students can take home or use on a field trip!

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
